What do you get when you put together four guys in vests, slamming rhythm, catchy lyrics, and a white sofa? You get **Love in October**, an up and coming group from Minneapolis, Minnesota.

Love in October formed in 2006, after Erik (vocals and guitar) and Kent Widman (bass) moved from Sweden to pursue a musical career in the U.S. After adding Nik Pfieler (guitar) and Mike Swanson (drums) to the lineup, Love in October has built a rather large fanbase from their popularity on Myspace, hilarious videos on Youtube,

and touring the midwest exhibiting their theatrical rock and roll. Live shows not only include their rock-pop, but Broadway-style skits and improvisation, making Love in October a feast for the eyes and the ears.

Their sound is a blend of rock-inspired rhythm, pop-flavored melodies and choruses, and reflective lyrical prose. Erik's well-rounded vocals compliment any style of song, from a cool ballad to a turbulent power-pop tune. Love in October has been compared to Motion City Soundtrack and Ok Go, but their sound is also similar to Rooney, The Starting Line, and Saves the Day. While Love in October may not be one of the most conventional bands hatched out of the midwest, they are certainly one of the most interesting, making you want to get out of your seat and dance to every song they play.



Though Love in October has only been performing since the summer of 2006, they've already recorded their debut EP **"Words of Sound"** (which will be released February 27, 2007), with the help of Ed Rose (Motion City Soundtrack, The Get Up Kids, Puddle of Mudd) at Black Lodge Redording Studio in Kansas. Love in October's **"Words of Sound"** tour begins in February of 2007, with at least 17 tour dates across the U.S.
